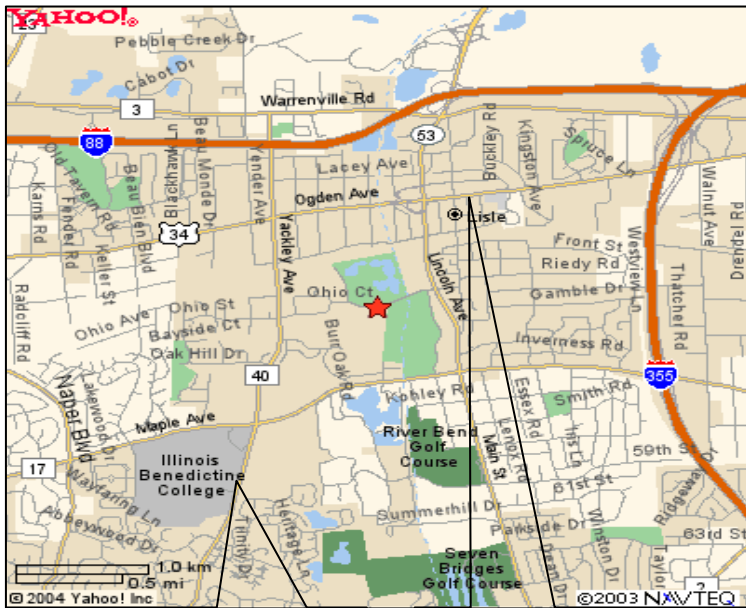

Directions to Lisle Commuter Lot:

From the East:

On I-88 exit IL-53 ❖ IL-53 becomes Lincoln Ave. ❖ South to Burlington Ave. ❖ East to commuter lot

From the West:

On I-88 exit Naperville Rd. ❖ South to Ogden Ave. ❖ East to Main St. ❖ South to Burlington Ave ❖ East to commuter lot

From the North:

South on IL-53 ❖ IL-53 becomes Lincoln Ave. ❖ South to Burlington Ave. ❖ East to commuter lot

From the South:

North on Lincoln Ave/IL-53 to Burlington Ave. ❖ East to commuter lot

Directions to Benedictine University:

From the East:

On I-88 exit IL-53 ❖ IL-53 becomes Lincoln Ave. ❖ South to Maple Ave. ❖ West to Yackley Ave. ❖ South to Benedictine University parking lot

From the West:

On I-88 exit Naperville Rd. ❖ South to Maple/Chicago ❖ East to Yackley/College ❖ South to Benedictine University parking lot

From the North:

South to IL-53 ❖ IL-53 becomes Lincoln Ave. ❖ South to Maple Ave. ❖ West to Yackley Ave. ❖ South to Benedictine University parking lot

From the South:

North on Lincoln Ave/IL-53 to Maple Ave. South ❖ West to Yackley Ave. ❖ South to Benedictine University parking lot

Parking Instructions:

Participants may park at **Benedictine University** (5700 College Road • Lisle, IL) or the **Lisle Commuter Lot** (925 Burlington Ave. • Lisle, IL). Both remote parking locations are conveniently located less than a mile from the Walk site.

Shuttles will be available to take all walkers to the Walk site from these locations. Shuttles will run from 7:30 a.m. until 1:30 p.m.

****Please Note: No dogs on the buses.** Dogs are welcome on site, but must be dropped off at one of the **Drop-off locations:**

1. Short St. & Ohio Court
2. Short St. & Rte. 53

Parking is available on site **ONLY** for walkers with official JDRF assigned permits. **Please note: handicap parking is available on site.**

Walk Day Information:

Bring your completed walker collection envelope with your team name, team captain name, and Walk site. Remember, we need a separate envelope for EACH individual who has collected contributions. Additional envelopes will be available at the site to mail contributions collected after the Walk.

A light lunch will be provided for all walkers; snacks and other refreshments will be available at the checkpoint along the route.
